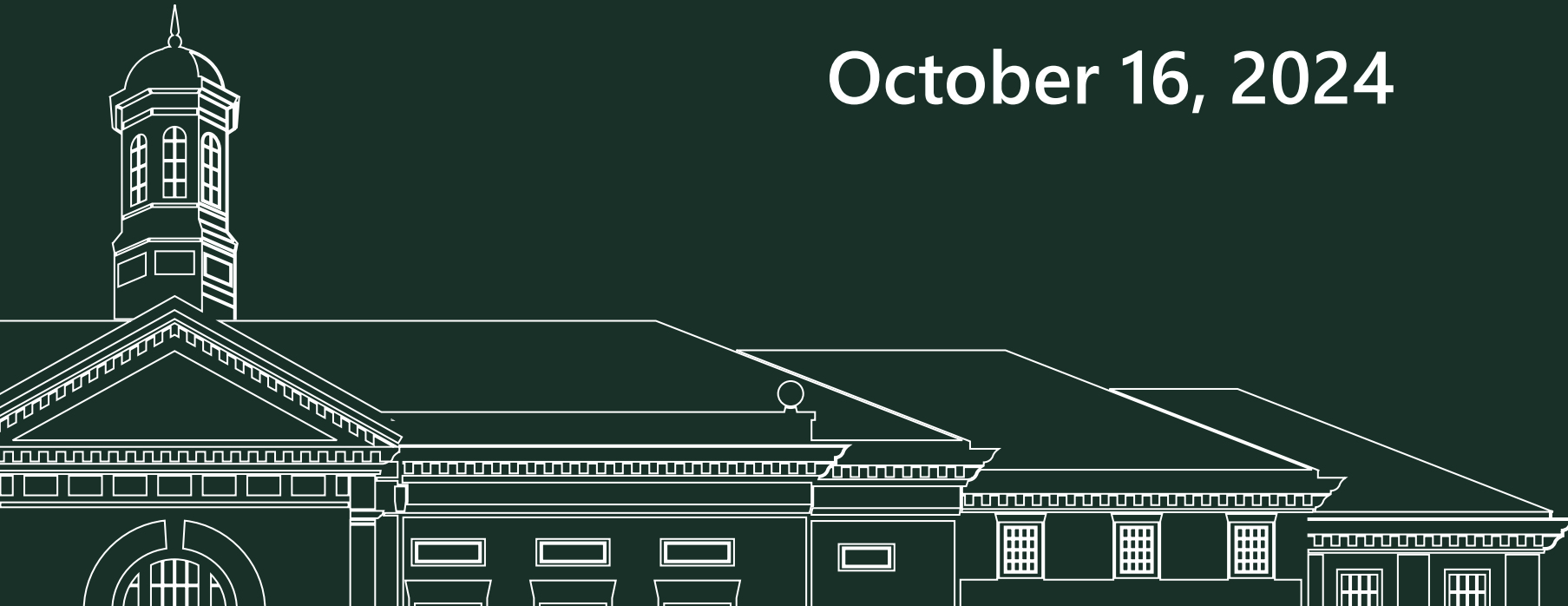

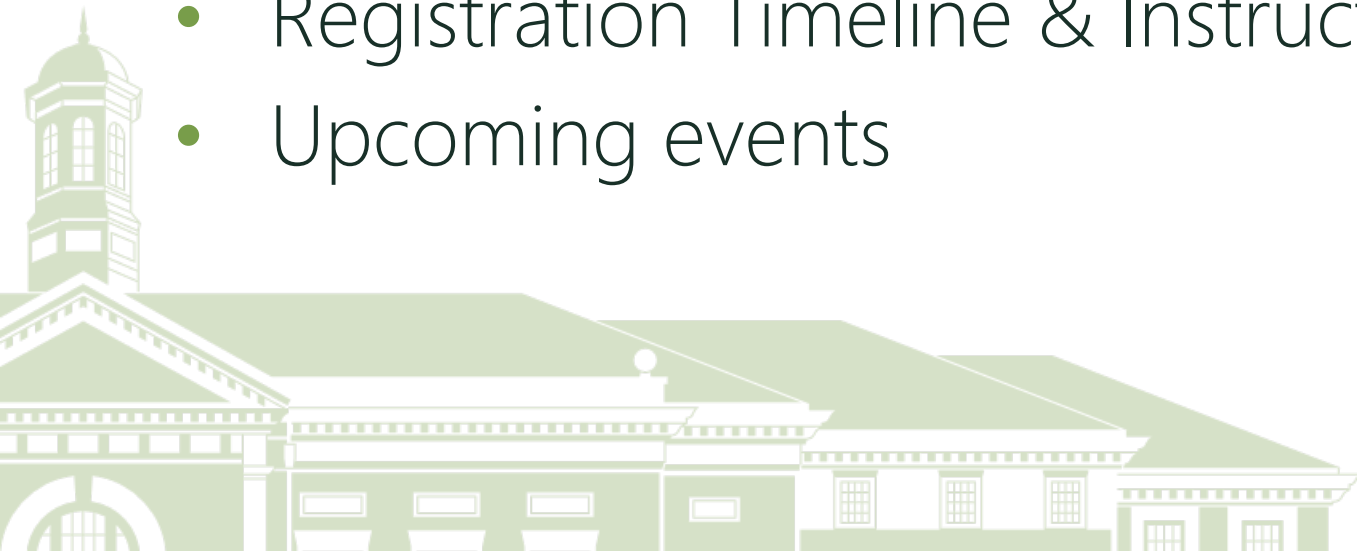

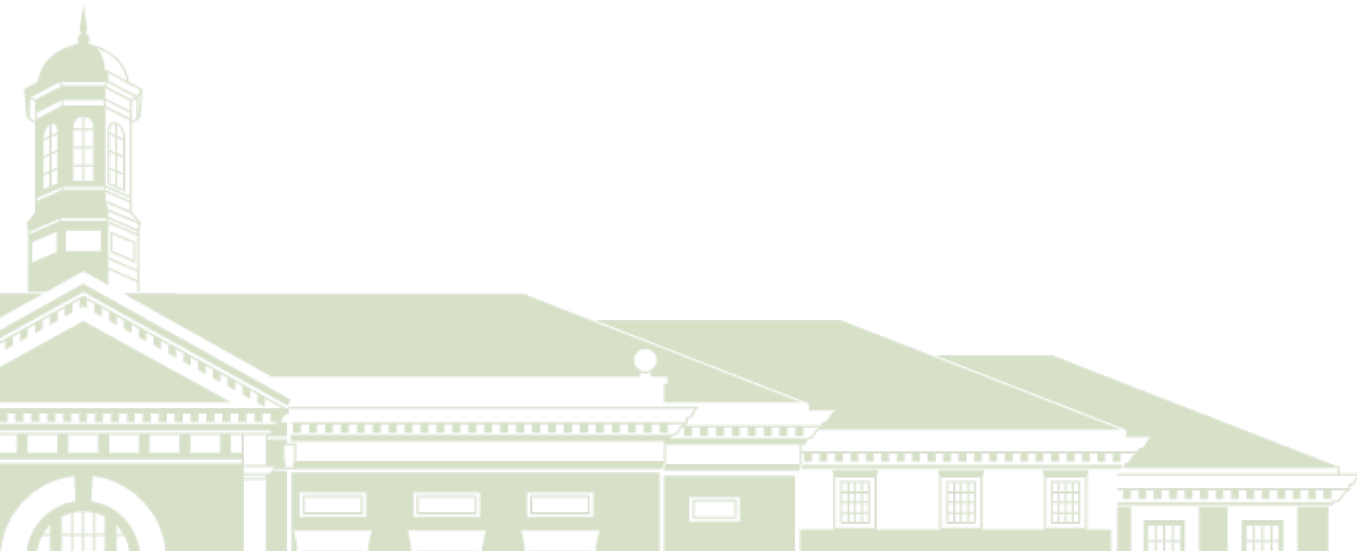
Class will be held the week after spring break (3/17-3/21). It is the only required course in the spring. The MAcc Program will register students into the class.

We will also include a “Welcome Back” luncheon for all students that week.



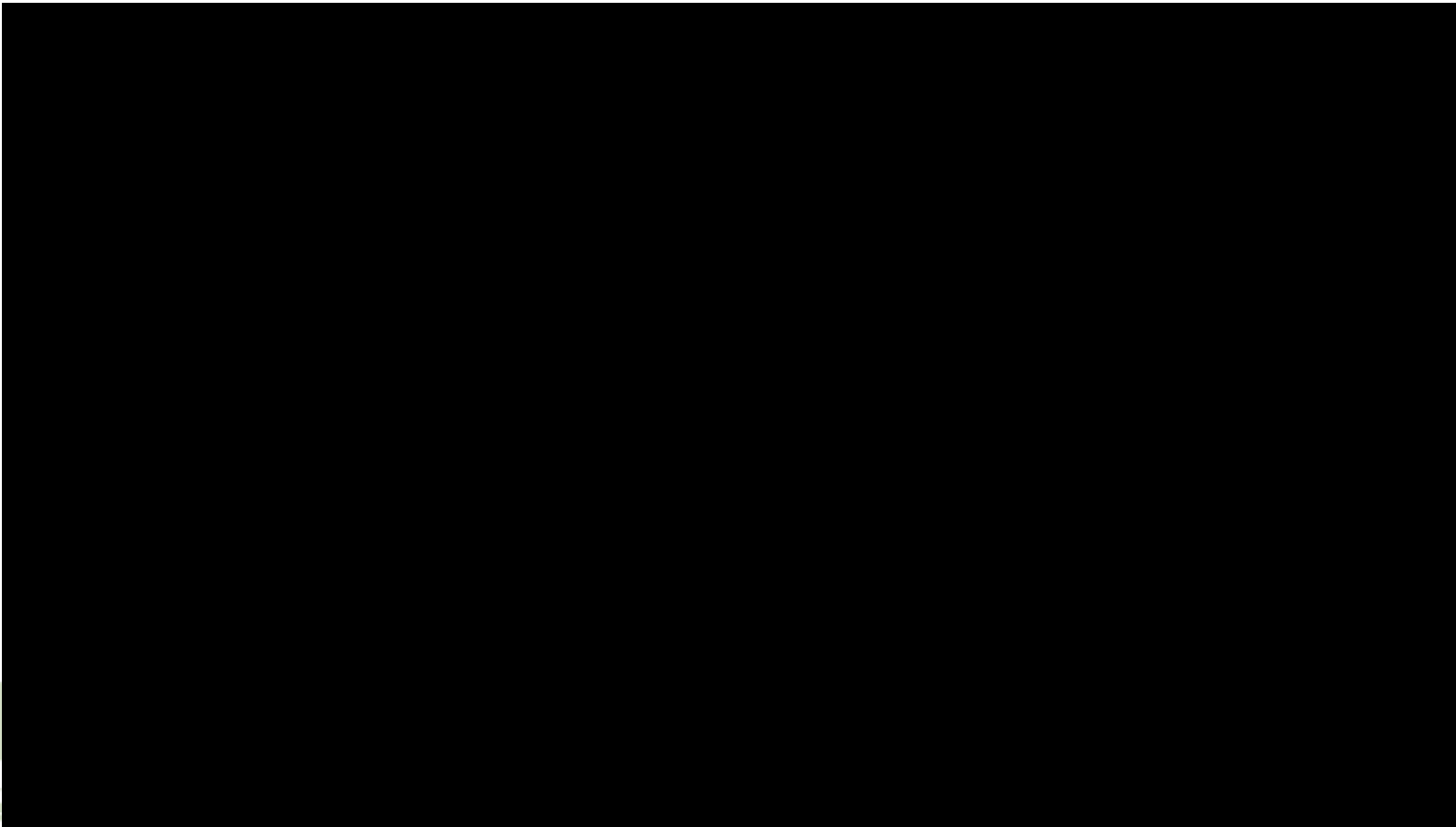

Emphasis Declaration

The MAcc degree, regardless of emphasis is a STEM degree (with the opportunity for a 24-month OPT extension for qualifying international students). Students may choose to take a deeper dive into a particular area of accounting by choosing one of the following emphases. Some students choose no emphasis. Only one emphasis will be listed on your student record. [Emphasis Declaration Form](#).

This form is due on Tuesday 1/21/2025 (first day of spring semester).

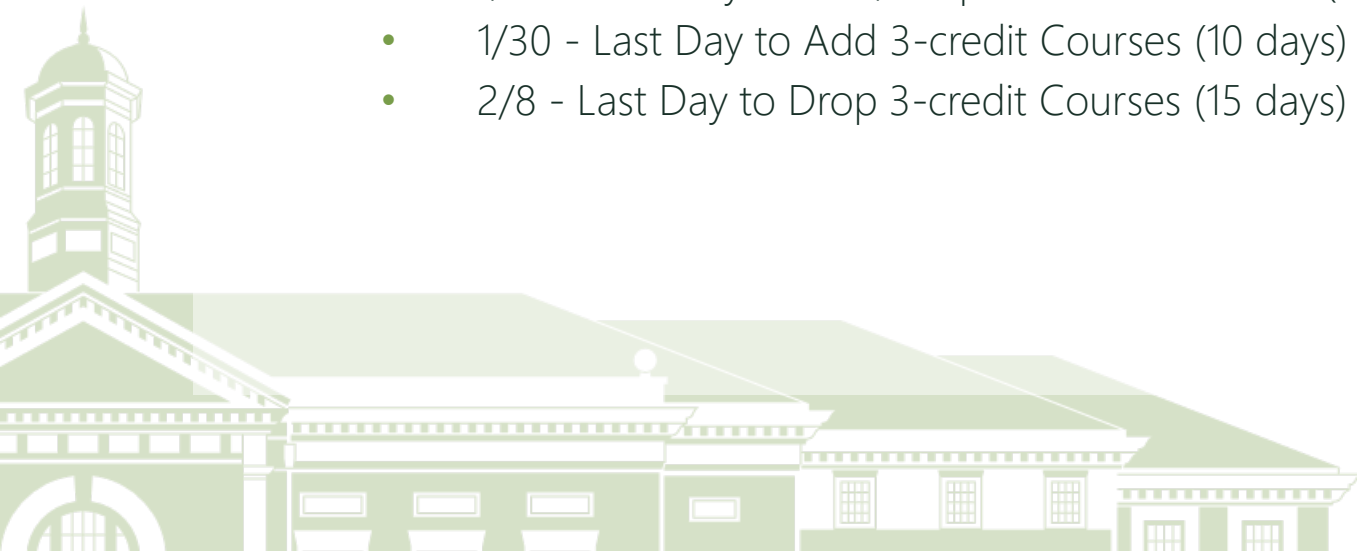

*Students who participate in BUAD 6129 – Integrated Winter Field Experience (IWFE) must declare an "Experiential Emphasis" and may not declare a different emphasis even if they meet the requirements for another emphasis.



Registration Timeline

- **Monday, October 21 (8:00 am)**
 - Registration for MAcc Students to register for MAcc Classes
 - Students should register for full semester, session C and Session D
 - MAcc Program office will register you into Sprint Week
- **Tuesday, January 21 Classes Begin; Add/Drop Begins**
 - 1/25 - Last Day to Add/Drop 1.5-credit Courses (5 days after start of semester)
 - 1/30 - Last Day to Add 3-credit Courses (10 days)
 - 2/8 - Last Day to Drop 3-credit Courses (15 days)







PATH – Important Notes








Important Notes:

- Co-requisite courses will be processed in the same round **as long as you have added them to your primary cart.** The highest priority assigned to a course in the co-requisite 'group' will be applied to the whole group
- If more than one course has the same priority assigned, PATH will use the auto function to evaluate which course to attempt first (*auto serves as a "tie breaker" in these situations*)

Registration Holds – resolve before carts close!
Holds display at the top of your cart. PATH will allow you to build a cart even if you have a hold, **but your course selections will not be processed if your hold is still active** when carts close.

Registration Errors – review your cart and resolve before carts close!
PATH displays registration errors in the cart. Resolve any issues before carts close, or remove the section from your cart and choose a different course

Request to Take Non-Program Course

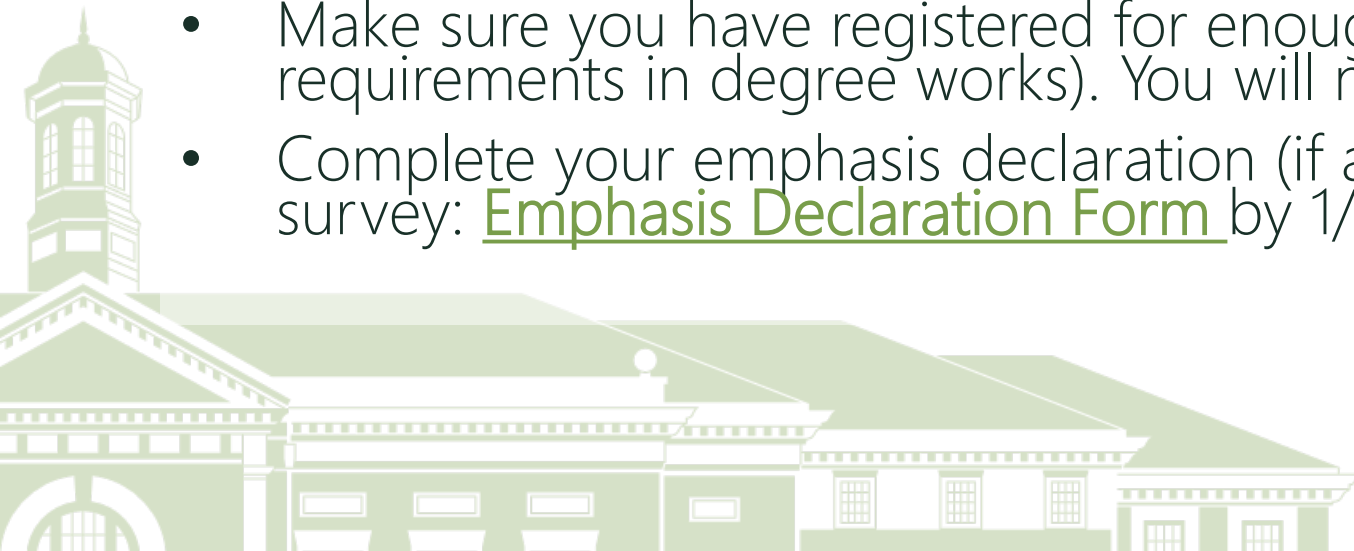
If you want to take an MBA course that requires instructor permission, please take these steps:

1. Make sure you meet all prerequisite course requirements before proceeding.
2. Complete the ["Request to Take Non-Program Course for credit"](#) form.
3. Return the form to the MAcc Program office along with transcript attachments that prove prerequisites have been met.
4. Upon approval, the program office will register you into the class.



Please Note:

- Make sure to select the correct term "Spring 2025"
- There is a location tab available if you only wanted to see courses available at the Miller Hall or Peninsula Center.
- The MAcc Program will register you into your Sprint Week Course (BUAD 5039).
- If there are any holds on your account, you cannot self-register
- Register for all classes (including Term D). You can change your mind later if you want to add/drop Term D classes.
- Make sure you have registered for enough credits to graduate (see requirements in degree works). You will need a total of 30 credits
- Complete your emphasis declaration (if applicable) by completing this survey: [Emphasis Declaration Form](#) by 1/21/2025 (if possible)

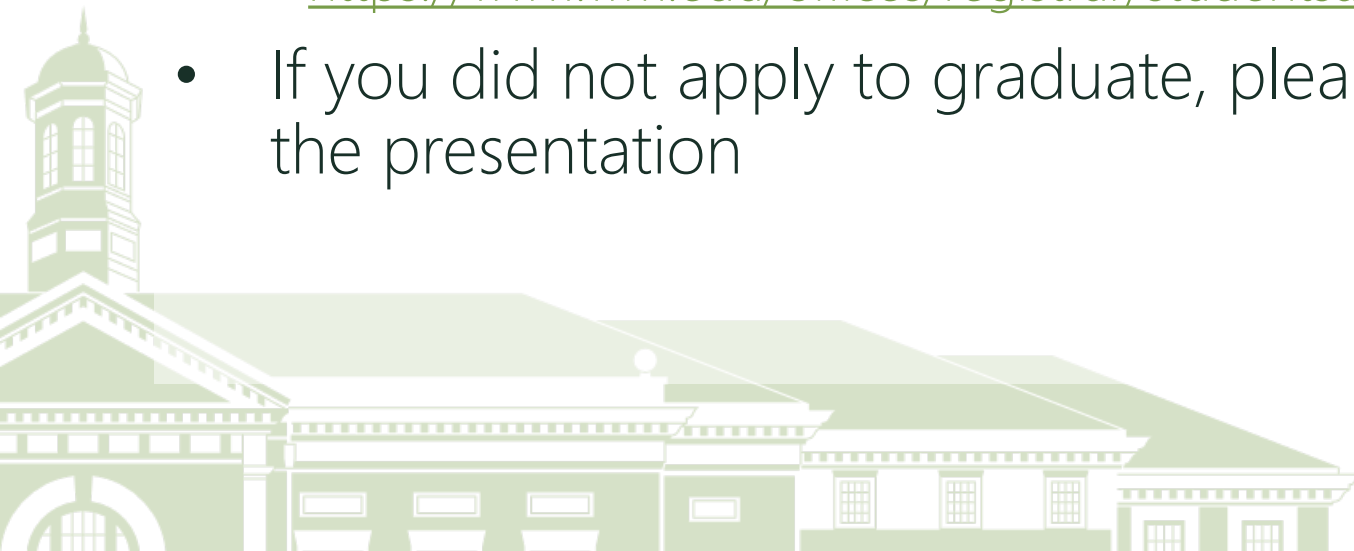


Apply to Graduate – The Deadline has passed

- There is a charge that will be placed on your account for graduation processing fees.

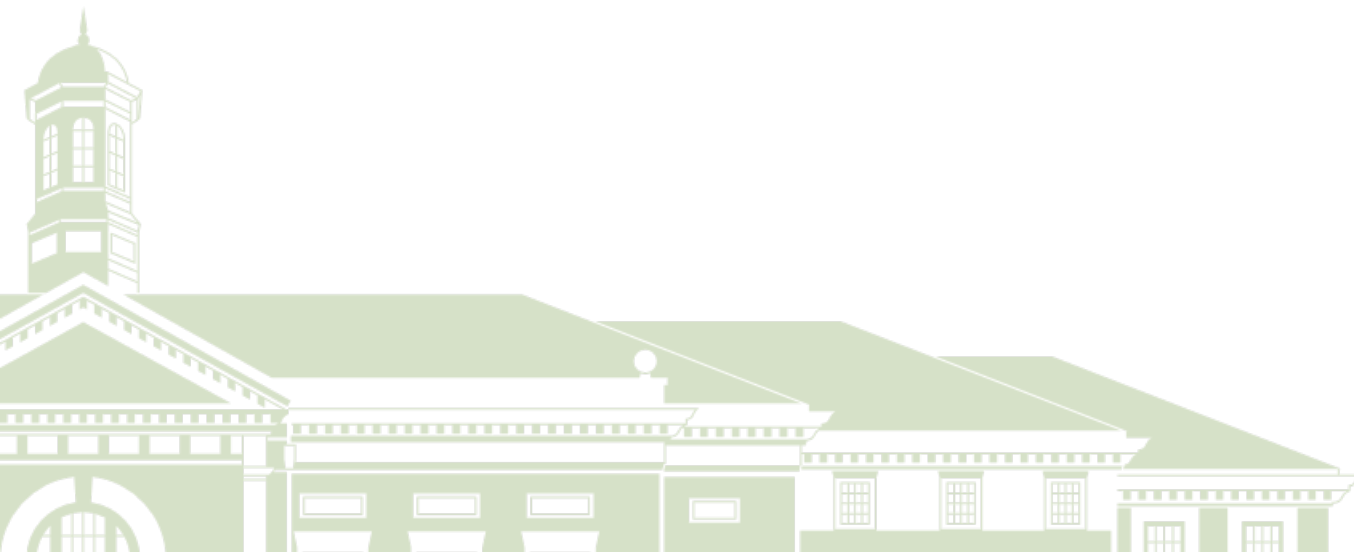

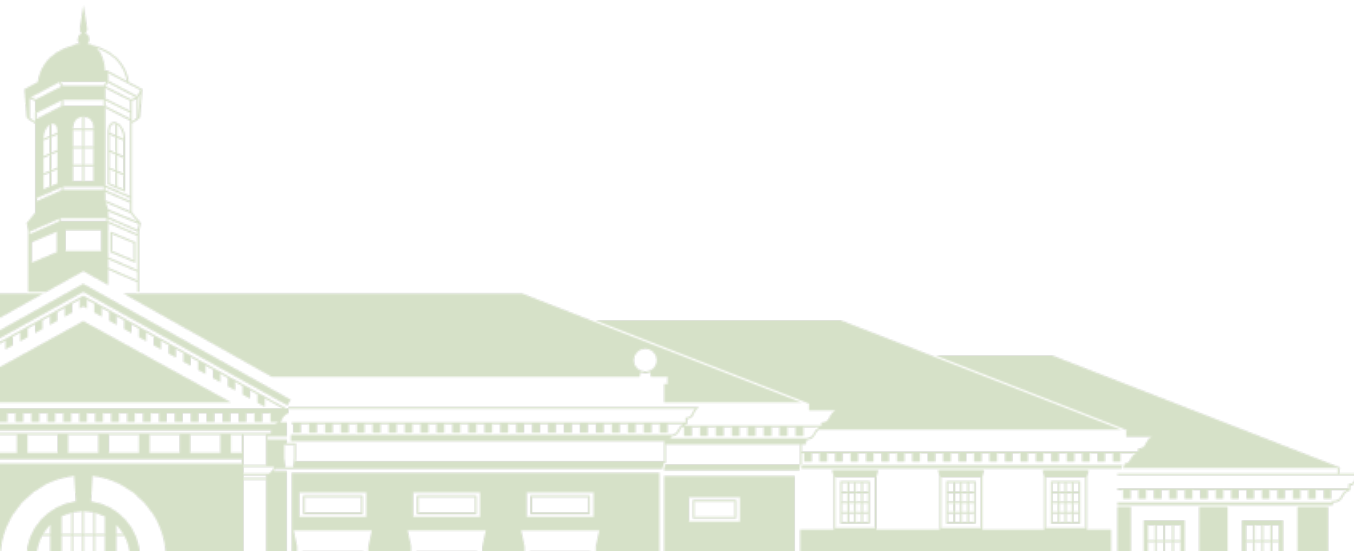
