If you are planning to graduate from the Flex MBA Program during the Spring 2021 or Summer 2021 semesters, your Notice of Candidacy form MUST be completed in <u>Banner Self-Service</u> by October 1, 2020 in order to ensure that your degree is conferred on-time.

Flex students intending to complete their degree requirements this Spring should select "May 2021" as their degree conferral term and students completing in Summer should select "August 2021".


